

The prefix *ad-* (*ac-*, *as-*, *af-*, and *ap-*) can be added to many Latin roots to form nouns and verbs. A double consonant occurs where the prefix joins the root word.

The prefix *ad-* is spelled

- *ac-* when added to roots beginning with *c*
- *as-* when added to roots beginning with *s*
- *af-* when added to roots beginning with *f*
- *ap-* when added to roots beginning with *p*

**SPELLING CLUES: Words With Prefixes** When you proofread your work, check for words that begin with *ac-*, *as-*, *af-*, or *ap-*. If these are prefixes, the consonant is usually doubled. Then check the rest of the word for correct spelling.
