Each Spelling Word has a prefix and a suffix added to a base word. Notice that the spelling of these base words does not change when the prefix and suffix are added.

Sort the words into three groups based on their prefixes.

**UN-**  
unknownable

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**RE-**  
reestablishment

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**DIS-**  
displacement

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The prefixes *un-*, *re-*, and *dis-* change the meaning of a word but do not cause the spelling of the base word to change.

The suffixes *-able*, *-ment*, *-ly*, *-al*, *-ful*, and *-ion* change the way a word is used and sometimes cause the spelling of the base word to change.
