SPELLING CLUES: Comparing Spellings When you proofread, look for words that may be misspelled. If you rewrite the word in another way, you can often see which spelling is correct.

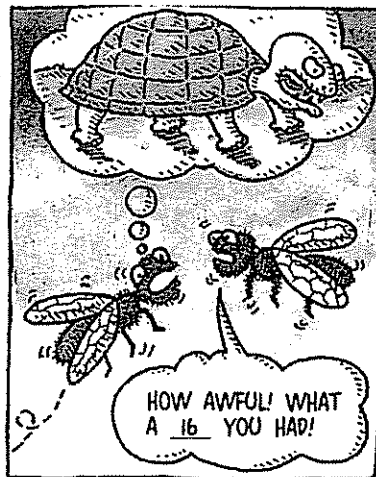
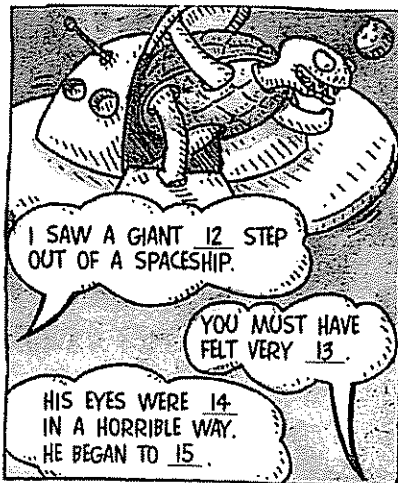
